Enrolment & Payment procedures

- Enrolment forms must be completed for each student before commencing classes.
- An enrolment fee of \$35 per student is payable at time of enrolment to cover insurance, administration fees & music licensing costs.
- All accounts are paid by term. No weekly payments are accepted.
- Parents are NOT permitted to watch classes. Busta Move will try and have an open day in term 1 and 2 to allow immediate family to watch.
- Once you/your child have enrolled in a class you must remain in that class for the term. If your child no longer wishes to continue a class NO REFUNDS will be given.
- Once you/your child have enrolled in a class this enrolment will continue through to the next term. If your child does not wish to continue please advise Miss Emma by email.
- Once enrolled ALL classes must be paid for. No credits will be given due to sickness, holidays, school camps etc.
- Accounts over \$300 may use Busta Moves payment plan.
- Any account still outstanding after the due date will incur a 10% late fee.
- If payment is not received by week 5 of term the student may be asked to leave the class and enrolment will be forfeited.
- All students participate at their own risk.
- Class packages will be applied to all students taking 3 or more classes.
- Class package cost is per student/per term. Price remains the same regardless of term length.

Dancing Etiquette

- If you/your child are going to be absent from class please advise Miss Emma before the commencement of the class.
- Please ensure that you/your child arrive on time for your class. Late students disrupt the class and don't give the dancer adequate warm up time.
- Parents and children must speak in a respectful and positive manner at all times within the studio.
- If there are any problems or negative issues please direct them to Miss Emma and the problem will be rectified to the best of her ability.
- Please only bring water into class. (No cordial or soft drink)
- Please put your child's name on all shoes (inside), clothes, drink bottles, bags etc.

Classes offered

- Busta Move offers classes in Modern Jazz, Tap dancing, Hip Hop, Acrobatics, Classical Ballet, Lyrical, Contemporary, Strength & Conditioning & Technique extension.
- Classes are offered to pre-schoolers (2-5yrs), juniors (6-8yrs), intermediates (9-14yrs), seniors (15+) and adults from beginners to advanced dancers.
- Competitions are also offered to any student that wishes to take part. Competitions are great for a child's self-confidence and self-esteem. It allows them to perform on a stage against other dancing schools in a friendly atmosphere. They can either do a solo, duo/trio or be part of a troupe item. If participating in competitions a Busta Move jacket must be ordered to represent our school.
- Troupe classes are by invitation only. Students will be chosen at the discretion of the teacher.
- A child must be taking a class in the subject they wish to compete. (eg. if they wish to do a tap solo they must be taking a tap class)
- Private lessons are held on Sundays and/or Fridays.
*Please ask Miss Emma about private lessons if your child wishes to do competitions.

Class Pre-requisites

- **Acro**
Acro classes are based on ability, not age. Therefore there are pre-requisites for each class
Junior Acro Level 1 - no pre-requisites
Junior Acro Level 2 - Standing bendback and pull up, 1 handed bendback and pull up, 1 individual balance, 2 & 1 handed cartwheel both ways and front feet over.
Intermediate Acro - Front tineski, back tineski, 1 handed tineski, handspring, 1 handed handspring and 2 individual balances.
- **Lyrical**
Children under 15 can only join lyrical if they are doing a ballet class.
- **Technique Extension**
A class dedicated to helping dancers focus on technique while preparing their body with the strength to enhance performance, minimize the risk of injury and promote longevity.

Parking at the Studio

- Please do not park in the bays directly in front of the studio. These are reserved for Busta Move STAFF ONLY.
- Please do not park at Hungry Jacks or Unit 22 Commerce Street.
- Please do not park in the bays belonging to the printing company when they are open.
- For the safety of all the children at BMDA please drive slowly when entering the carpark.

Costume Fund

- There will be a costume fund available for people who wish to take part. The idea of this fund is to make weekly installments of a small amount (ie \$5.00) so that at concert time it is a little easier on the budget.

Dress Code

- All students are to dress appropriately for the class they are enrolled in.
- Hair is to be neatly pulled back at all times.
- **NO DENIM** is to be worn to any class.
- **NO JEWELLRY** to be worn to any class.
- Pre-schoolers – Leotards, dance pants, singlets, ballet skirts are acceptable. Pumps and tap shoes are required for this class.
- Jazz - Dance pants, dance shorts, singlets, leotards are all acceptable. *Preschoolers and Juniors* are required to wear pumps only. *U/12 jazz class to Seniors* will need tan split sole jazz shoes and elastics MUST replace the shoelaces.
- Tap – Same clothing for Jazz class with the exception of Tap shoes, rubbers MUST be on the bottom of the tap shoe. ****Energetiks tap shoes are NOT allowed****
- Acrobatics – Leotards, dance shorts, tight singlets, dance pants are required for this class. Clothing needs to be tight fitting and hair MUST be in a bun. Students in Junior acro classes will not need shoes however children in Intermediate/Advanced acro will need pumps or jazz shoes. These should be fitted with “grips” from a boot maker.
- Hip Hop – Comfortable clothing. Singlet, tracksuit pants, dance pants, sneakers are all acceptable.
- Ballet – Students must wear a leotard and pink ballet stockings. In the warmer months a ballet skirt and socks are also acceptable. Ballet pumps must be worn by all students and hair MUST be in a bun.

Shoes can be bought from “Ballet Boutique” in Morley (Ph: 9375 7508) or “Sequin City” in Wangara (Ph: 9409 9369)

IMPORTANT TIPS FOR SHOES:

1. All tap shoes must have rubbers (fitted by a bootmaker not a parent)
2. All tap shoes are either Bloch or Capezio. (No Energetiks)
3. For students in the U/12, U14 & Senior Jazz classes that have a tendency to “roll in” their feet, Bloch Ultraflex jazz shoes are recommended. (Shoelaces will need replacing with elastic)
4. Bloch Elastboot jazz shoes (slip on/no shoe laces) are only recommended if your child does not roll in their feet.
5. Jazz shoes/pumps and Ballet pumps should fit snug

Fundraising

- There will be numerous fundraising events throughout the year. The money raised will go towards concert trophies, props, concert venue and many things to make our Busta Move studio a better place to be.

Some fundraising ideas are:-

Also as a small and fun fundraising idea there will be fun days for the children at dancing (pyjama day, crazy hair day etc). On these days we ask for a gold coin donation. Look out for the notes throughout the year as to when these are on.

Concert

- At the end of the year Busta Move will present a dance concert, held at one of the lovely venues in Perth. This is a great opportunity for students to show family and friends all their hard work throughout the year.
- We do encourage participation however the decision is completely up to you. This is not compulsory. A concert participation note will be handed out throughout the year.
- Once agreeing to take part in the concert a costume deposit will be due. This deposit will go towards buying material and accessories and will come off your total invoice when the costumes are ready.
- If you have agreed to be part of the concert students must be present for at least 90% of their classes. It will also be COMPULSORY to attend the stage rehearsal and the dress rehearsal. (Dates and times given closer to the date).

PLEASE NOTE: Deposits are NON REFUNDABLE so please be sure to check dates, times and availability before agreeing to take part. If you change your mind and decide not to take part then costumes that have been made must still be paid for.
